For this celebration, students are required to make a replica, or a model, of a California Native American Village. This model should be made on a 2 foot x 2 foot piece of plywood or sturdy cardboard. Native Americans used many natural resources, so students should use twigs, clay, grasses, leaves, or any other materials that they might find in their own backyard!

Each student will have researched a tribe in the classroom, so their model should represent their chosen tribe.

Please attach an index card to the base of the model that indicates the tribe, type of dwelling, and lists the natural resources the Native Americans used to make it. Don't forget your own name!
