

# Book Report

\*This project must be on a book that you have *recently finished*.

What you need:

1. Paper sack
2. Crayons or markers
3. Material, yarn, etc to enhance project

What to do:



1. Wad up sheets of old newspapers and stuff paper sack until full.
  2. Tape the top of the sack closed.
  3. Decorate the paper sack to look like one of the main characters in your book.
  4. Complete the attached book report form.
- Return your project *and* book report form by Thursday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>.
5. You will be presenting your book report to the class on the due date above.

Oral Presentation:

1. You need to know the story of your book- the setting, main characters, main idea, and even tell us your favorite part.
2. Explain how you prepared your project, and why you chose the character that you did.
3. Let the class know why you would recommend this book to a friend. Classmates may ask you questions about your project and book, and the *presentation should last about 2 to 3 minutes.*
